Agenda Item: Presidents Report

Presenter: John Camacho, President

- Surveys were distributed to District 75 parents and 627 surveys was returned, citywide.
- The outcome and other related information will be posted on the council website.
- Mentioned the February Calendar Meeting at Tweed Courthouse, topic and guest speaker.
- Newly appointed by council roll call vote Amy Ming Tsai will serve as the Chair of the Committee on Busing and Safety.
- The council met with Dr. Linda P. Chen at 721Q and she provide the council with her vision for the 25 thousand plus students attending District 75.

Agenda Item: Report of the Superintendent

Presenter: Shelly Klainberg, Deputy Superintendent

- Shelly Klainberg, Deputy Superintendent attended the meeting on behalf of Ketler Louissaint, Superintendent.
- After 40 years of service Deputy Superintendent, Barbara Joseph will retire from the Department of Education on February 1, 2019.
- Stems for Girls meets on Saturdays. Students engage in Stem technology and coding and other items related to Stem.
- The Fathers Initiative is a success. The fathers produced a mural in the lobby of the District Office.
- D75 met with 25 individual partners at the District 75 Office, i.e., art partners.

Agenda Item: Initiatives at Brookdale Hospital

Presenter: Tiffany Lawson, Registered Nurse, BSN and Caregiver Panelist at 2018 Respite Lifespan Summit, Council Member

Ms. Lawson presentation is based on initiatives of two major areas of concern when families in the community visit Brookdale Hospital, Brooklyn.

- Wait time in the waiting room is too long for families who have children with low tolerance of sitting for a long time.
- Medical professionals (doctors and nurses) were unable to handle the care for a child who has special needs.
- Therefore, Ms. Lawson pushed through with Brookdale Hospital to pilot program a better-equipped facility to
 accommodate children with special needs and their families comfortably and hospital staff that are better trained to
 handle different situations that may occur when a child is not comfortable during examination.

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- An improvement in their Triage Department:
- An area of triage is rooms that are specifically for the child and his/her family.
- These rooms have fluorescent bulbs that are more kid friendly since some children are sensitive (by sound waves) to the sound that regular bulbs carry.
- I-Pads will be available to keep children entertained will waiting or during examination.
- More funding on training for current physicians and nurses in recognizing and better understanding techniques a child who may be nonverbal using PEC boards (pictures)
- Lastly, she asks the Council to assist with the following:
- Pushing out to other medical professionals and hospitals to start the same initiative to better accommodate children with special needs at their facilities.
- Ms. Lawson will start up a survey for council to review & outreach in support of her cause.
- Ms. Lawson asks District Deputy Chancellor Klainberg to relate it back to the District team in seeing if District 75
 Educators can help train or guide medical professionals to the necessary strategies on handling a special needs child.
